We are experiencing the wonderful grace and the favor of God on our work, especially during the last couple of years. Many opportunities, growth and change are on the table for our work in Africa.

One year before we launched Judea Harvest in 1999, God spoke to me, and said that I would have to go to a foreign country, live there and gather the bread of life for my brothers in Africa, (like a modern day Joseph). In January of 2022 we relocated to Tyler Texas to expand Judea Harvest's work in the USA. We managed to add another 2 470 house churches to the Kingdom of God in African countries during 2022.

What is important is to note that these churches are not cell groups. House churches are an evangelistic tool to reach out to unchurched and unreached people.

Judea Harvest uses the John Journey strategy to plant house churches. This programme was developed in Africa, by Africans for African pastors.

Testimony:

My name is MBUH TRUSTIN NYOWIKEH, a pastor, missionary and church planter in Cameroon. Back in 2011, I was fully convinced of my call to ministry and went in for Theological formation. When I left the seminary in 2015, I knew I was called more as a missionary but my then denomination didn't have room for missionaries. I stepped out and planted a church and a year later, I came across an organization that fitted perfectly into my call, JUDEA HARVEST.

From August 2016 till date, I've seen my ministry come to life as I'm able to serve in the area where I find fulfillment. Through Judea Harvest and her resources I've been able to plant four churches, train more than 200 pastors and church leaders, host numerous crusades in very remote and sometimes dreaded areas in my country.

Judea Harvest conferences, seminars, camps and training sessions has helped me to be able to acquire contextual knowledge for my African ministry setting.

Through Judea Harvest assistance to over 10 churches, I've been able to foster some level of unity between denominations and churches which has always been my dream.

MBCs and John Journey have been powerful training tools for the youth of my local assembly. I presently serve as the Regional Manager of Judea Harvest in Cameroon.

I'm grateful for the ministry opportunities Judea Harvest has Given me.



CHURCH PLANT TENTS

209 TENTS PLANTED IN 2022

A marque tent still remains the best possible way to transform a house church into a community church in South Africa.

During 2022 we have supplied 209 marque tents to new church plants in Africa. This brings our total number of tents distributed to date to 3992.

Testimony:

When Ps Hilton started his church, he did not have a tent. Services would take place at his house but his house was not big enough to accommodate many people. We praise God that the membership has increased tremendously since he started using our Judea Harvest tents for services and we shall continue to pray for this church to reach greater heights.

Testimony:

Pastor Leon Kivitz, a pastor of The Christian Fellowship Ministry in a small area in Kimberley is a pastor who is dedicated to the work of God and cares about his community and loves serving God.

He has started working for the Kingdom of God and holding church services in his house and sometimes they could not accommodate the people that were coming to the services and had to be under a tree or rent halls in order to continue with ministering to the people.

This year in October, Pastor George and his church, heard about the story of Pastor Kivitz and his family, and how they are serving and sacrificing for God's people with the little that they have. Pastor George

visited the family and saw how this man was serving selflessly and how his family supported him and he was deeply moved. He went back to his church and they prayed and made a way to raise funds to bless this Pastor with a tent that can accommodate 150 people.

With God's help, they managed to raise the funds and drove to Judea Harvest in Pretoria to collect the tent and drove all the way to Kimberley to deliver this tent to Pastor Kivitz and his ministry.

Upon arrival, the pastor, his wife and some of his leaders received this gift with such great joy and the very same Sunday they pitched the tent and decorated it beautifully, and what a sight it was.

God continues to work through pastor Kivitz and the people of his community are blessed. We praise God for Pastors like Pastor George, who not only take resources for themselves but make means to bless those who really need assistance.

Herewith the story of AFM Dalewe in Lesotho:

Pastor Tlotliso Mphatsoe was appointed pastor of the AFM Dalewe Congregation during May 2020, at the peak of the Covid-19 pandemic in Southern Africa. The congregation didn't own a designated building and as such services were held at buildings on "loan". Logistically it was very challenging for the frail congregation members to attend gatherings, and Pastor Mphatsoe opted for the utilization of his private residence to hold church services and to attend to the growing needs experienced within the community. Pastor Mphatsoe trusted the Lord for the provision of infrastructure to serve this purpose, and his faith and trust were fulfilled by the approval of funding for the erection of the Dalewe Church.

Dalewe Church is situated outside municipal boundaries, in the mountains of Lesotho, approximately 20 north of the town Quithing. The road leading to this rugged terrain is daunting, and as

such presented the biggest challenges during the construction of the church. Special transport had to be rented in order to deliver materials to the site. The 2x4 vehicles from Judea harvest were unable to reach the site carrying loads. Travel time to the site was lengthy due to the poor road conditions, and good planning was essential to sustain continuous traction during the construction progress.

Regardless the challenges, God's blessing on this project were visible throughout. The project was completed well within the planned timeframe, and are serving as a beacon of hope for the community of Dalewe. The congregation is growing steadily as word of the new establishment spreads, and community members are reaching out for guidance, counselling and support during these challenging times. We praise God for the opportunity to make a difference in this community.

TEACHING TOWERS DEPLOYMENT

485 TEACHING TOWERS Distributed Across 25 African Countries

Those small miracles are really a Godsend. Technology has made it possible to create a very small solar powered device that can stream or download Christian videos and audio files, free of any cost to any cellphone, tablet or computer via Bluetooth and WIFI technology.

These Teaching Towers contain the full Bible on audio, the full Jesus film, a full audio and video curriculum for pastoral training, sermons, children material and other Christian content.

Christian and non-Christians like Muslims, can download information to their cellular devices and grow spiritually.

Judea Harvest has distributed 485 of these devices across 25 African countries during 2022. That brings our total distributed amount of Teaching Towers to 1250. These devices are placed in churches, school, Bible schools, businesses and even taxi ranks.

Testimony

I am Pastor Habib from Benin. Benin is a country situated in heart of West Africa, which is one of the nations that commonly practices “Vodun religion”. This practice involves rituals such as animal sacrifices and spirit possession (mainly known as voodoo).

In this country Islam is also a dominant religion, access to Christian content is not easy and bibles are extremely expensive to buy. Those who are seen carrying bibles in most villages are shunned and disowned by the community. Foundations/MBC partnered with Judea Harvest in distributing Light Stream Devices (Teaching Towers) that helped in how people perceived Christianity and eventually building a personal relationship with God.

Pictured below are the recent converts from Islam who are actively using the Light Stream Device also known as a Teaching Tower. The Teaching Tower video contents has been popularized in addressing issues such as Facing fear & Finding freedom, Dealing with sin and How faith works. Such videos are streamed by an average of 100 people with 81 downloads per week.

From DR. Danie Reynecke

CEO JUDEA TRAINING



Judea Training is part of the Judea Harvest world since day one. The purpose of this department is to address the current and future training needs of the African church. The mission of Judea Training is to take sound elementary Biblical training to pastors all across Africa. The vision of Judea Training is to empower 1 million African pastors with elementary Biblical training over the next 30 years. The following are some of the training programmes that was offered during 2022 and 2023.

The Yao project focusses on evangelism and house church planting in 3 countries namely Mozambique, Tanzania and Malawi. Traditionally the Yao is a Muslim tribe that is not very open to the Christian faith. However, the project was launched during 2022 and was received with thankfulness. Twelve key leaders started with the John Journey programme and the Foundations course. These 12 leaders are made up of spiritual leaders, young pastors, senior pastors, house church planters and evangelists. In addition, these leaders also selected candidates that they are currently training and managing to implement and run the Yao project. All of these candidates are from the Yao tribe. At the moment there are fifty-seven church planters that receives personal training through this arrangement.

I had the privilege to visit Lichinga in Mozambique during February 2023. While travelling in the area I felt as if everything has come to a complete standstill. I was taken back in time 70 years. It is not difficult to experience the primitiveness. I was told to be careful and not to take any photos openly. Being sensitive to the situation I sensibly asked the question as to why the people choose to live such a lifestyle. Some of the explanations were that this is what they know and this is their culture. However, isolated from the rest of the

world, they do go around and do their daily activities. I can understand that evangelizing in these areas is very challenging. This will take time as one need to start with friendship evangelism first and journey into discipleship programmes. Our team however is obedient to the Great Commandment and spend a lot of time in prayer for their mission.

Another training programme that was started during 2022 is the Novartis project. Although this is not Biblical training in nature it offers Africans critical information regarding medical diseases and conditions. This project includes 6 medical information audio lessons of 2-3 minutes each. These are: Malaria, Diabetes, Breast Cancer, Dysmenorrhea, Glaucoma and COPD. These lessons are offered in the following languages: Portuguese, Ndebele, Southern Sotho, Tswana, Afrikaans, Shona, Chichewa, Lozi, Tsonga and English. 5000 Audio units were distributed from the Judea HQ throughout February and March 2023 within the SADC region. Local distributions will start during April 2023.



The audio Bible training which includes the John Journey and the Foundations programme is as always satisfactory. The John Journey offers relevant Africanised evangelism, discipleship and house church planting strategies to the student and pastors. The Foundations programme offers a systematic Bible curriculum that consists of more than 215 individual audio lessons that is supported by online printed workbooks. The programme is offered over a three-year period and are managed by regional managers and deans. The following story of Pastor Joseph Nsiki testifies to the success of this programme:

I am pastor Nsiki from Mpumalanga. I am the RM for Judea in Mpumalanga. I also do training in some parts of Mozambique and Eswatini. These two countries are less than 30-minute drive from my house in South Africa. Many pastors in our area want to learn to become a pastor. But this is not that easy. To study to be a pastor is very hard and expensive. New pastors cannot leave their full-time job and become full-time students alone. The Foundations programme with the John Journey lessons come and stand in this gap. All my new pastors must complete this programme. Once they completed the John Journey lessons, they must then plant house churches. They must also complete the whole Bible survey lessons. This helps them to understand the message of the Bible much better. They learn the context of the Bible books. Every year I do a graduation with Dr Danie and we have graduated more than 250 new pastors. Thank you very much.

The Winning Horses initiative is a joined programme between Judea Harvest and Judea Training. The goal of this programme is to transform local pastors into community pastors. Granting that all training within the Judea world is based on Biblical foundations, the Winning Horses programme also offers programmes such as the DISC profiling, the 7 system thinking zones and personal brain profiling. These are presented to help the participant to have a better understanding of him/her self. Another segment of the Winning Horse's programme is community, city and town analysing and plotting. This assists the local pastor to understand his/her community better and to develop a relevant strategy to reach the community with the Gospel. The empowering of African women for the ministry is another part of the Winning Horse programme. The programme is presented via the Zoom platform and annual visits by Judea CEOs to West Africa.

The following January – March 2023 chart displays training measures, activities, church planting strategies and much more. People providing and compiling the feedback are Area Managers, Regional Managers, Senior Pastors, Deans and ECD Teachers. Feedback is offered quarterly via synoptic diagrams and stat reports. These hands-on reports come in on a daily basis and are practical, dynamic and also a work in progress.

Introduction

In 2022 Judea Hope achieved an ongoing active success in providing food and nutrition, safety and education to disadvantaged women and children in Southern Africa. Judea Hope focuses on investing in the future of underprivileged women and children. We aim to promote social and economic empowerment of women in disadvantaged and rural communities. Our goal is to provide development, care and protection to children thus enabling them to grow and develop to their full potential.

Judea Hope has been project managing an array of up-liftment and development projects

in South Africa. These projects focus on vulnerable children in the rural, RDP suburbs, and informal settlements in South Africa, where we have established more than 1 400 ECD centres. Judea Hope has formed various strategic national partnerships with relevant role players to maximize our services and support offerings to the children. During our past 23 years of existence in the Judea Harvest Group, we have established our capability and dedication in transforming the lives of women and children in previously disadvantaged communities.

Elevate Early Childhood Development/Discipleship Training

Judea Hope has developed a program that is cost effective, practical and easy and fun to learn, as most of our teachers have little to no educational qualifications. Judea Hope is equipping students and caregivers with our impressive Early Childhood Development and Discipleship training called Elevate ECD. Its aim is both to enable and to motivate the teacher / ECD practitioner so they will not only be well prepared but also deeply inspired for the work they do. Judea Hope's goal is to assist the teachers to effectively apply their newly gained theoretical knowledge and practical skills in their daily class activities and ensuring that thousands of children can learn, eat, play and develop. Thus far we have trained more than 1 845 students and teachers.

Judea Hope is exceptionally privileged to report that we are impacting the lives of 140 000 children and 6 500 teachers in education.

Graduation

The importance of a student graduating is that a qualified teacher has the knowledge and expertise to teach their children effectively. These equipped and well prepared teachers know how to engage their children in learning and ensure they understand the material/ lesson being taught.

Master Trainers

Judea Hope aims to train, equip and resource our team of Master trainers that are positioned across the country in all nine provinces. These Master trainers will in turn train all the students and ECD practitioners in their respective areas on Early Childhood Development, Children's Discipleship and towards school readiness. Our Master trainers are trained and develop to position us to achieve the long term goals and objectives that we have set. To date Judea Hope has 22 qualified Master trainers countrywide.

Entrepreneur Development Training

Judea Hope has a practical and affordable Entrepreneur Development (training) program. This program is based on the Entrepreneur training books written by Graeme Korner. This program aims to provide entrepreneurs with the knowledge and skills necessary to evaluate, start and run viable businesses but also help the entrepreneur prepare a solid business plan. To date Judea Hope has trained 220 students.



The Jesus Story booklets and storyboards

Judea Hope has exposed and equipped 65 000 children in 650 crèches with the Jesus story booklets and storyboards. Judea Hope aims that the children will be on a mission, carrying the banner of Christ to places still unchurched, not on the receiving side of the mission needing to be reached. Children's discipleship helps children to grow in their faith and build their faith on a strong foundation so that they can then disciple and lead others to Christ.

ECD Hope Centres

Judea Hope has embarked on a project whereby we assist pastors, ECD teachers and caregivers with the construction of new buildings for their crèches as these buildings guarantee long term sustainability focusing on children. To date we have built 33 Early Childhood Development centres.

Vegetable Tunnels

Due to the overwhelming need of providing food in our crèches countrywide, we have developed a more sustainable model of producing food for our crèches. The crèche is taught to produce food by themselves in the tunnel that is built on their crèche premises and children are engaged in this programme as part of the ECD curriculum. Each class takes turns every day to work in the tunnel, to learn and have fun in creating and producing their own food. This is a more sustainable way of producing food and has an excellent added benefit that education in agriculture at grass root level is taking place simultaneously. Judea Hope is very excited about this project and anticipates it to make a massive impact in our communities as already seen in our existing tunnels. Thus far we have built 78 vegetable tunnels.

Unique Nutritional Approach

Judea Hope has formulated a dehydrated rice, vegetable (barley, split pea and lentil mix) and legume-based meal with a vitamin and mineral supplement added, that provides all the macronutrient needs for a child and even an adult and provides the day care centres with food packs. The meals are packed by volunteers from the corporates, churches and schools packing 20 000 meals in 3 hours, in a fun and engaging team building style



event. Dr. Anton Janse Van Rensburg is a medical practitioner, holding a Master's degree in Nutrition, and is our specialist nutritional consultant. Lastly these meals are distributed and delivered to our network of Early Childhood Development centres across the country, where we facilitate a day trip/field trip to our donors and partners. We are proud to announce that we have packed more than 7 000 000 meals over the past 10 years.

Beyond our Borders Malawi / Tanzania / Mozambique

Judea Hope has successfully completed the training, equipping and resourcing of Child Ministry workers in Malawi, Tanzania and Mozambique. Receiving resources and training in their mother tongue assisted these Child Ministry workers to have a better understanding of the material and further reach their communities. In Malawi we have trained and equipped 950 Child Ministry workers and in Tanzania and Mozambique we have trained and equipped 100 Child Ministry workers.

Judea Hope is a registered NPO and has an Article 18 A Tax Certification. We are a Level 1 BBBEE contributor and is 100% compliant and therefore donations qualify for the BBBEE scorecard. Judea Hope is privileged to receive gifts-in-kind throughout the year and we are excited to announce that these gifts-in-kind are distributed amongst vulnerable children and woman in previously disadvantaged communities.

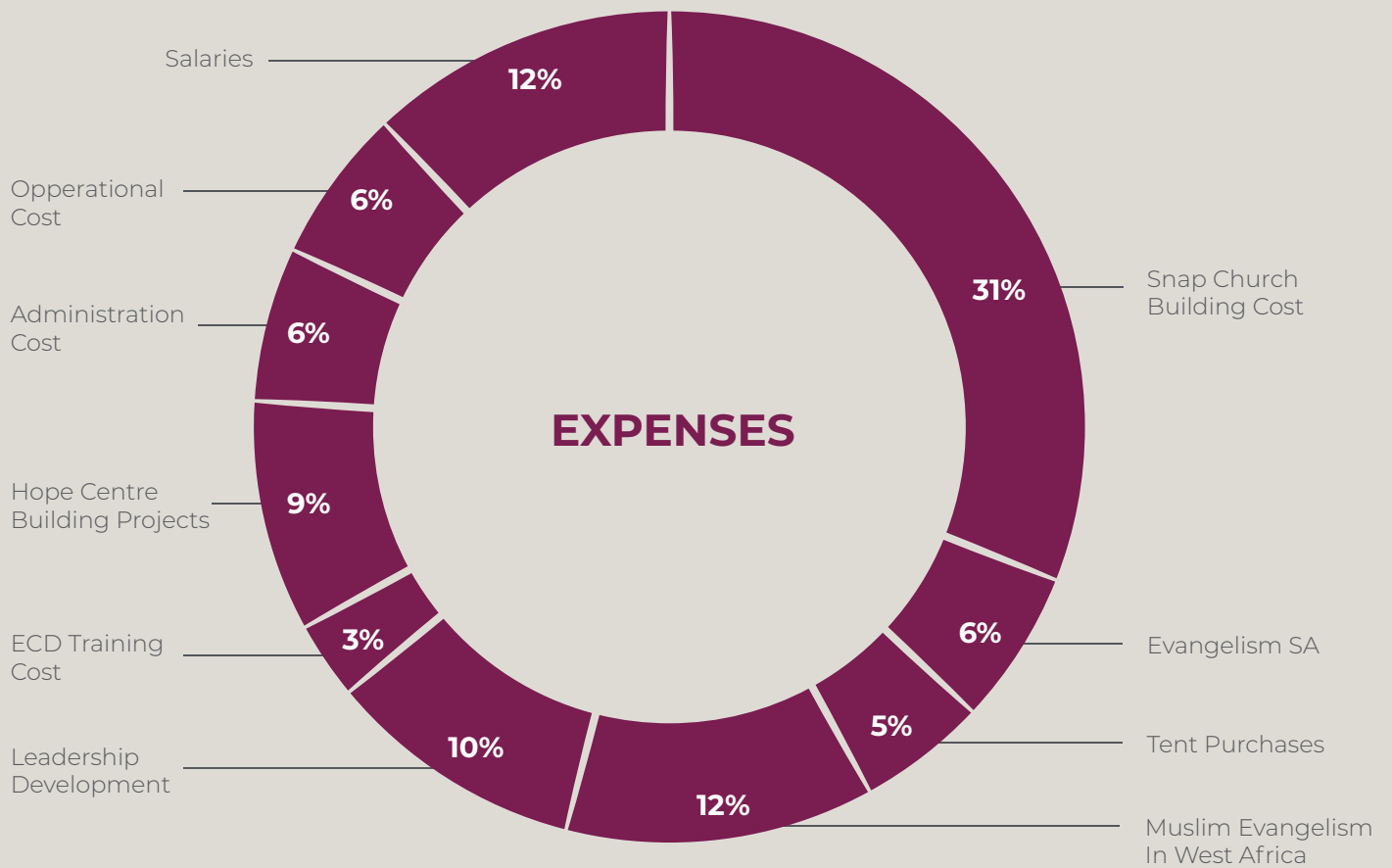

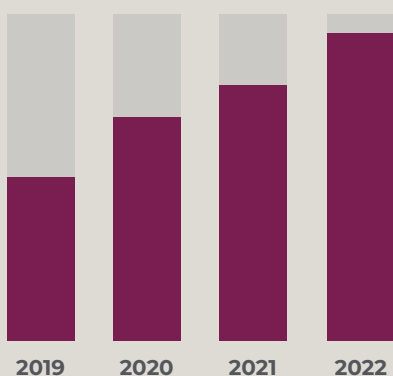

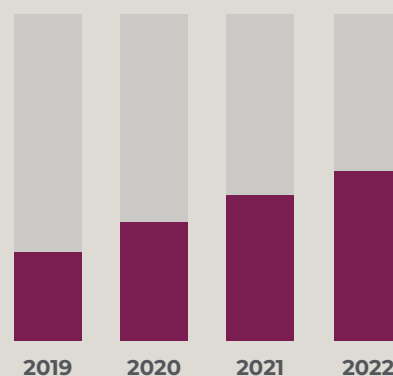
