Judea Harvest is threading like a fine piece of string through Africa, Touching/Sowing and Impacting communities with evangelism, church planting, child caring and training for our people in Africa. Judea Harvest encompasses three distinct and related ministry strategy platforms: Judea Harvest, Judea Hope, and Judea Training. Each division is explained in detail later on.



# Taking the Church to the People



**W**e are now completing the third year of our West Africa strategy. We are grateful for the leadership, resources and wisdom we have received from our Lord, to help us reach West Africa.

## Challenges

As expected, border post, customs and bureaucracy have been our greatest challenges. But the recent Ebola threat has hampered our travelling arrangements and possibilities, and made us aware that you have to use windows of opportunity when they arrive.

## What We Did

In 2013-2014 we have managed to train 40 church planters and Evangelists in the John Journey strategy, in 5 West African countries. We are happy to report that in TOGO close to 105 churches have been planted and new churches gets added to the list on a weekly basis. Reports keep coming in and we pray that this will become a movement.

In Cameroon we have exceeded 27 new churches and new churches continue to be planted.

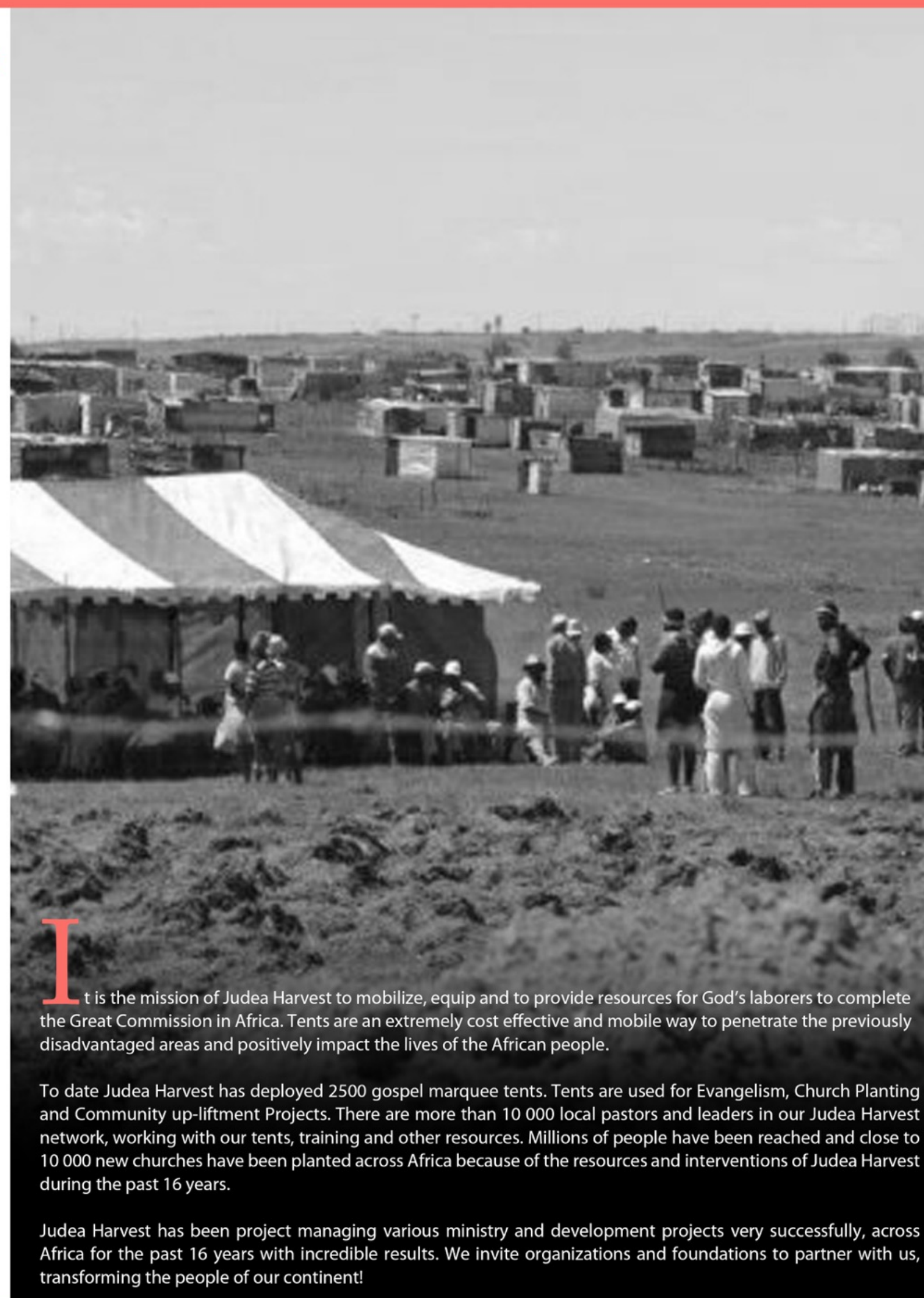
During 2014 we launched the John Journey strategy in Burkina Faso and are pleased to see 12 new churches being planted and trust for future growth. In 2015 we hope to expand to Chad, Niger, Benin and Ghana and we are really grateful for the way God is using us, to advance His Kingdom.

## Materials

We have been privileged to have distributed 1000 Audio Bibles to illiterate new believers and 3000 Bibles to new believers in 2014 and have deployed 400 000 copies of the Gospel of John to churches in Sierra Leone. We are happy we have succeeded with this project before the Ebola outbreak.

## Future Plans

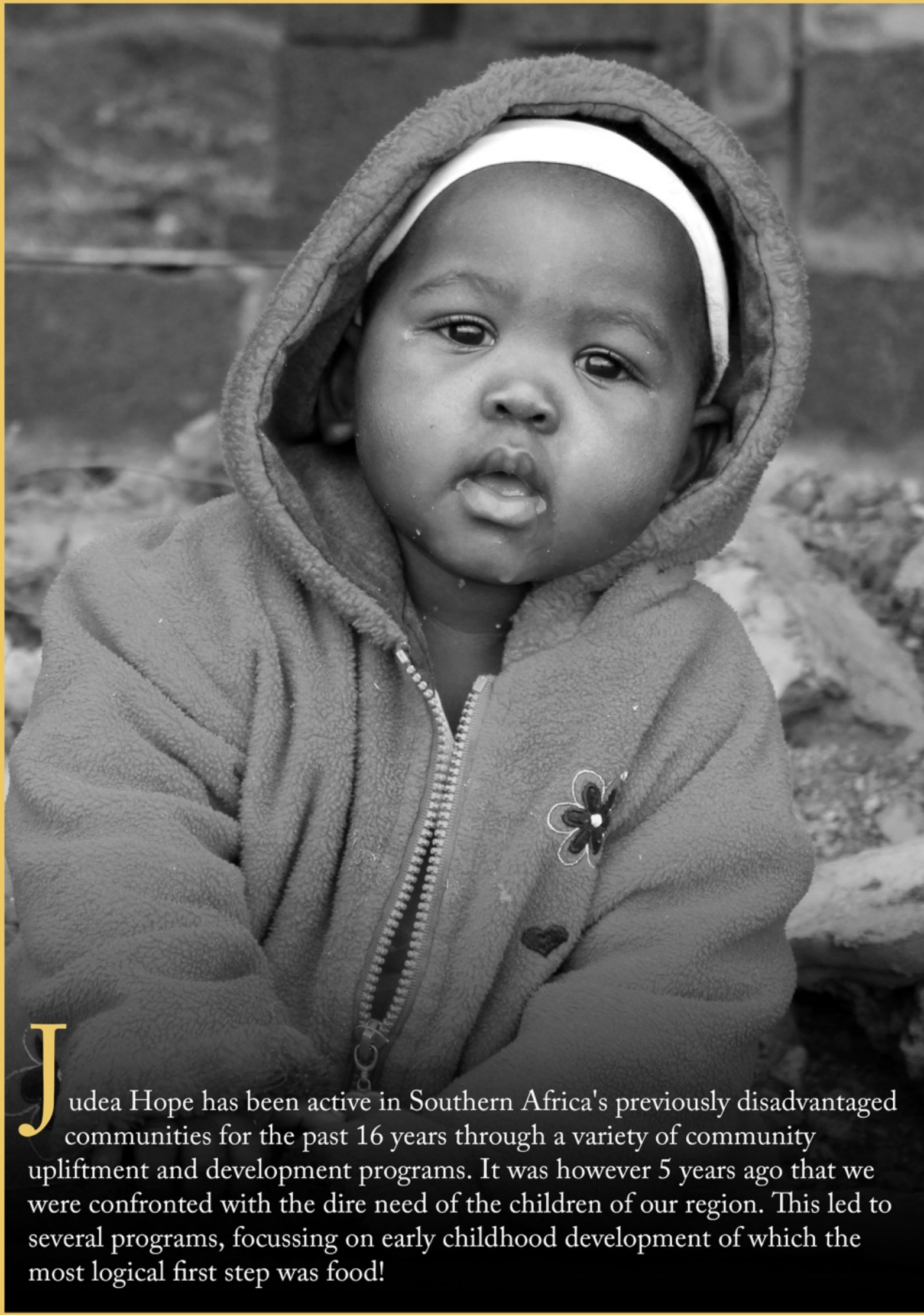
We plan to launch the satellite training system that was perfected in South Africa, in West Africa during 2015. Our vision is to plant 500-1000 satellite schools and equip them with satellite dishes and decoders to receive our training broadcasts. Additionally we plan to print 30 000 soccer Bibles and send them to West Africa with 400 000 copies of Gospel of John in French, Arabic and English languages. In this manner we hope to speed up the church growth in West Africa.



**I**t is the mission of Judea Harvest to mobilize, equip and to provide resources for God's laborers to complete the Great Commission in Africa. Tents are an extremely cost effective and mobile way to penetrate the previously disadvantaged areas and positively impact the lives of the African people.

To date Judea Harvest has deployed 2500 gospel marquee tents. Tents are used for Evangelism, Church Planting and Community up-liftment Projects. There are more than 10 000 local pastors and leaders in our Judea Harvest network, working with our tents, training and other resources. Millions of people have been reached and close to 10 000 new churches have been planted across Africa because of the resources and interventions of Judea Harvest during the past 16 years.

Judea Harvest has been project managing various ministry and development projects very successfully, across Africa for the past 16 years with incredible results. We invite organizations and foundations to partner with us, transforming the people of our continent!



**J**udea Hope has been active in Southern Africa's previously disadvantaged communities for the past 16 years through a variety of community upliftment and development programs. It was however 5 years ago that we were confronted with the dire need of the children of our region. This led to several programs, focussing on early childhood development of which the most logical first step was food!

**D**ay care centres and feeding  
 One of the major needs that we focused on was the creation of day care centres for thousands of children that had no place to learn (and eat). Through collaboration with religious and civic groups we have established 1000 informal day care centres that also serve as an ideal platform for the distribution of food.

**Unique nutritional approach**  
 Through research and consultation with local nutritional experts Judea Hope ([www.judeahope.org](http://www.judeahope.org)) has formulated a dehydrated rice, vegetable and legume based meal that provides all the macronutrient needs for a child and even an adult. To enhance the nutritional potency of the meal further a vitamin and mineral sachet was specifically formulated for the meal pack and is included in the packaging. This is added after the meal has been cooked. Soon after we had rolled out the first batches of food with our vitamin sachet anecdotal feedback started rolling in. There are too many testimonies to note in this document but feedback ranges from decreased illnesses amongst the children to improved general health of people living with HIV.

Sadly due to the overwhelming need we are currently only managing 3 meals per week at some of the 1000 day care centres.

**Unique participatory approach**  
 Since the meals have to be packed. We opted to invite companies to not just donate financially but to invite their staff to become involved as volunteer meal packers. This is done through a fun and engaging assembly line process where staff members pack the meals that their company has donated. On request we can also facilitate the production of a short, fun video that some organisations have used on their intranet.



**Million Meals Project**  
 Judea Hope ([www.judeahope.org](http://www.judeahope.org)) is planning a record breaking One Million Meal Packing event for 5 and 6 June 2015. The meals are packed by volunteers, from the corporates, churches and schools that donate R 25 000.00 for 50 boxes and 16 000 meals. Through a fun and engaging assembly line process, a team of 40 volunteers can pack 16 000 meals in just three hours. We plan to pack One Million meals in a 48-hour period, where the 65 teams will relay each other every three hours. The meals are highly nutritious, dehydrated meals comprising of rice, soy, vegetables, flavoring and 21 essential vitamins and minerals designed by a medical Doctor, Dr Anton Janse Van Rensburg. The meals are easy to transport, store and distribute to those in greatest need.

**Food for the brain**  
 Besides the food packs Judea Hope provides the day care centres with training material and the staff also receives basic literacy courses at university standard. All the material for children development is also supplied to the teachers

**BBBEE and Article 18 certificates**  
 Judea Hope is a registered NPO and has an Article 18a tax certification. Donations to the Judea Hope feeding scheme therefore qualifies for the BBBEE scorecard.



# Taking training to the people



**I**n 2013 Judea Training was founded to address the training needs of the millions of people in Africa that are doing ministry but have no training. The primary focus of our training is the untrained African pastor and his leadership. The vision of Judea Training is to take practical cost effective ministry training to the people. Research has shown that there are numerous Spiritual Leaders without proper theological and ministry training.

To train and equip these students Judea Training will produce a live Satellite Broadcast simulcast system. The broadcast will take place at a local church in a given community, called a JUDEA TRAINING CAMPUS. Through these broadcasts thousands of students will be reached with relevant courses and curriculum. The training methodology starts with a Simulcast; followed by DVD and Internet courses and workbooks. To date we have just more than 1000 training campuses across all the countries in Southern Africa, with more than ten thousand students that have been doing various of our life changing courses.

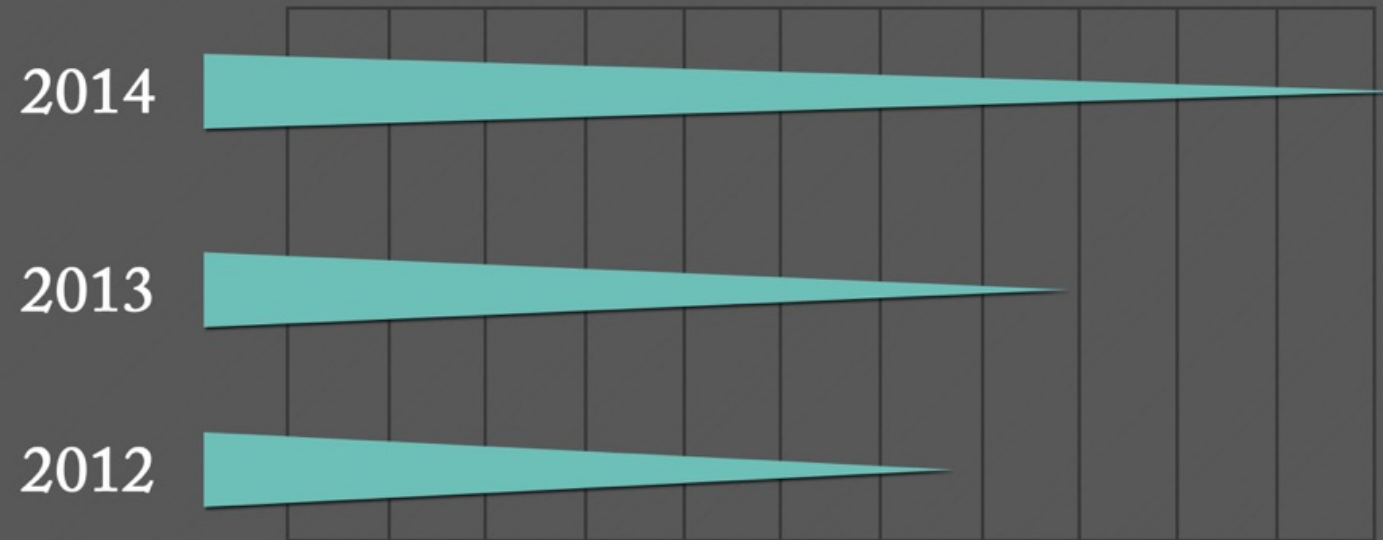

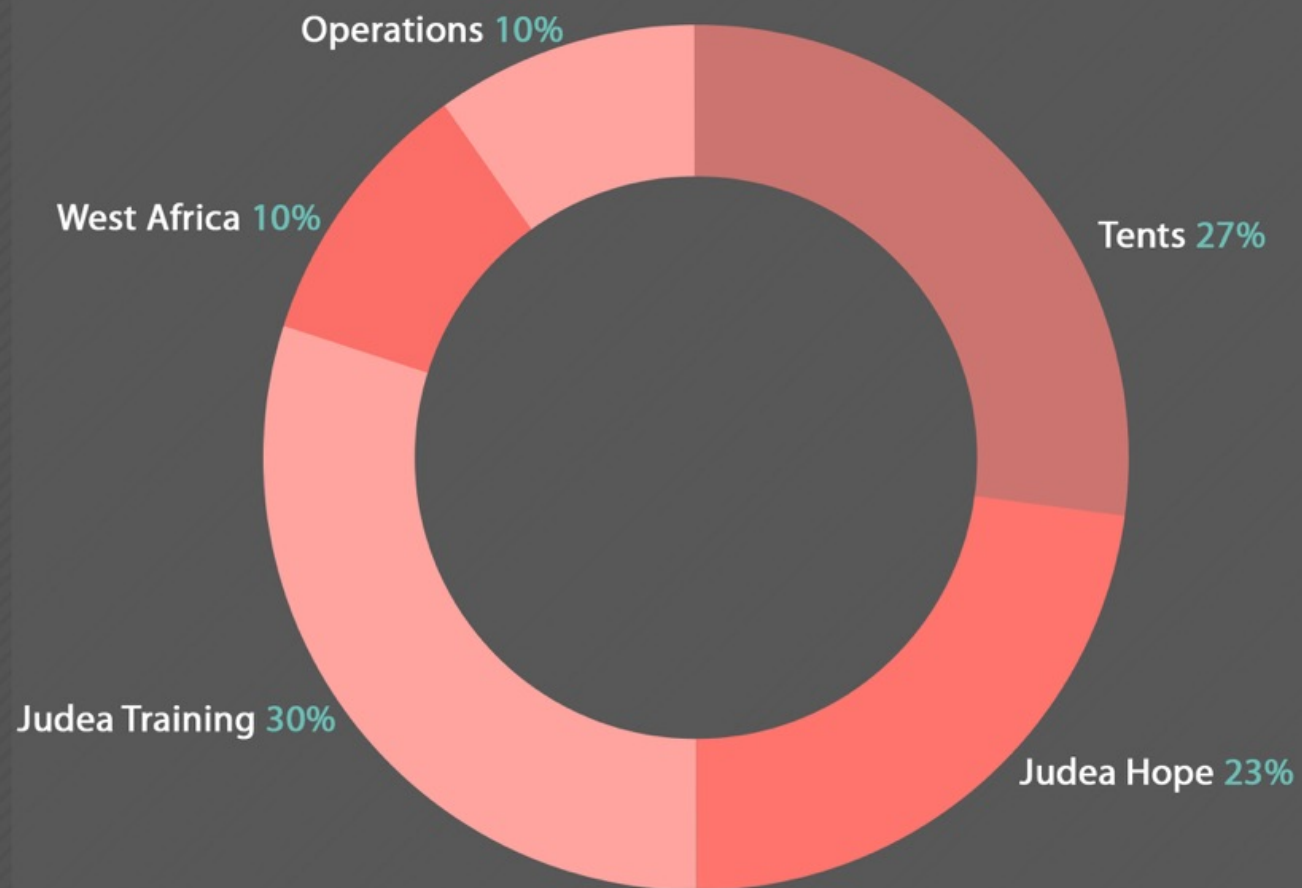
