t is the mission of Judea Harvest to mobilise, equip and provide resources to God's labourers to complete the Great Commission in Africa. Millions of people have been reached and close to 10 000 new Churches have been planted across Africa because of the resources and interventions of Judea Harvest since its inception in 1999. Judea Harvest has been managing various ministry and development projects very successfully, across Africa with incredible results. We invite organisations and foundations to partner with us, transforming the people of our continent!

Taking the Word to the People:

Our Audio Discipleship Course, for those who cannot read, a solar-powered Audio Bible in the native language is provided. With the help of the MBC (Mini Bible College), provided by ICM, an audio based discipleship Bible study course has been placed in every Judea Harvest church. This course consists of 215 lessons on the Bible. People listen to the lessons and then participate in group discussion. To date, Judea Harvest has donated 8 130 MBC Audio Bibles across 17 African countries.

Bibles:

There is nothing more powerful to help people know God and build a relationship through discipleship. In the last year, we have given a free Bible to every new convert in Judea Harvest outreach projects and churches. These Bibles are provided in the local language of the region and ±25 000 Bibles are distributed annually. In January 2016, Judea Harvest delivered 25 000 French Bibles to the harbour in Lome, Togo, West Africa.

Taking Church Planting to West Africa through John Journey:

The John Journey evangelism strategy is now in its third year since roll-out. The results are very encouraging and we are pleased to report that the strategy has been adopted by the local leaders as their own. They are now replicating and scaling the project by doing John Journey seminars on their own. The focus of these efforts is in the unreached rural areas.

John Journey is now active in the following countries:

Cameroon, Benin, Togo, Burkina Faso, Chad, Niger, Sierra Leone, Central African Republic, Kenya, Malawi, Zambia, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Mozambique, Botswana, Swaziland, Lesotho, Madagascar, Namibia, Nigeria, Ghana

Judea Hope has been active in Southern Africa's previously disadvantaged communities for the past 17 years through a variety of community upliftment and development programs. It was however 6 years ago that we were confronted with the dire need of the children of our region. This led to several programs, focusing on early childhood development.

Day care centres and feeding

One of the major needs that we focused on was the creation of day care centres for thousands of children that had no place to learn, play and eat. Through collaboration with religious and civic groups we have established 1300 informal day care centres that also serve as an ideal platform for the distribution of food.

Unique nutritional approach

Through research and consultation with local nutritional experts, Judea Hope (www.judeahope.org) has formulated a dehydrated rice, vegetable and legume based meal that provides all the macronutrient needs for a child and even an adult. To enhance the nutritional potency of the meal further a vitamin and mineral (sachet) was specifically formulated for the meal pack and is included in the packaging. This is added after the meal has been cooked. Soon after we had rolled out the first batches of food with our vitamin sachet anecdotal feedback started rolling in. There are too many testimonies to note in this document but feedback ranges from decreased illnesses amongst the children, to improved general health of people living with HIV.

Sadly due to an overwhelming need we are currently only able to supply 3 meals per week at some of the 1000 day care centres.

BBBEE and Article 18 certificates

Judea Hope is a registered NPO and has an Article 18a tax certification. Donations to the Judea Hope feeding scheme therefore qualifies for the BBBEE scorecard. Judea Hope has a level 1 BBBEE Rating.
















In 2017, Judea Hope started the Elevate Project which focuses on Early Childhood Development Program and to gain support from foreign donors in the West.

The ECD (Early Childhood Development) training program aims to train Pre-School teachers and give them a SAQUA Registered training certificate. The course ranges from personal teacher growth, to childhood growth, to teaching, to financial responsibilty, and to Digitial Tablet Training with Android Devices.

Elevate also aims to bring in foreign support through fellow organizations with donations. Currently, Elevate is operating in South Africa and the United States.

Studies have shown that there are at least one million preachers in pulpits every Sunday who have never had any theological training whatsoever. In many African countries churches have an average of only one trained pastor for every 20 churches (Buys, Theological Training for Untrained Pastors.www.christianlibrary.org.au).

Since 2013 Judea Training have trained more than 23 000 spiritual leaders with practical Christian one day courses. These leaders have completed more than 55 000 courses. These students were recruited within the Judea Harvest world. Judea Training have taken note that traditional Christian and Missiology training have changed dramatically during the last number of years. Very few students these days go for full time training at universities and seminaries. With this in mind Judea Training offers the following at the Judea ASM Training Campus Whiteriver. South Africa.

- Introductory Christian Training. This will include Evangelism, Missiology, Church Planting and Church Administration.
- Training will be on-line and short training stopovers at the ASM Campus. These contact classes take place over four days at a time. During the contact classes students will also have to do practical community work.






















